Membership Registration

Visit the National Library of Korea website (www.nl.go.kr) and sign up for membership



Issuance of Library Card

- ◆ (Regular/Daily Library Card) Bring your ID to the Library Card Issuance Office and get your library card
- ◆ (Mobile Library Card) Access the library's mobile website or app and log in



Storage of Belongings

- ◆ Items for Storage : Personal belongings excluding items like laptops and writing instruments
- ◆ Storage Method : Log in at the belongings storage room (Choose between ① scanning the card or ② logging in with your unified membership account) → Select a storage locker number → Store your belongings



Entrance

- ◆ Scan your library card at the entrance gate for entry

* To utilize the digital library services, it is necessary to reserve a seat or space in advance via the 'Digital Library Reservation System (nl.go.kr/dl_reservation)' before entering

- Advance Reservation

Available from 7 days prior to the visit

- Same-day Reservation

- Multimedia Area, Seminar Room, and Studios → Available from 00:00 to 5:00 PM
- Computer Lab, Library Digitized Resources, Laptop Zone, and Media Editing Lab → Available from 00:00 to 5:50 PM on the day of the visit



Outing and Conclusion of Use


- ◆ (During Absence) Scan library card at the outing processing terminal → Scan library card at the exit gate
- ◆ (Upon Conclusion of Use) Insert the one-day library card at the exit gate or Scan of the regular/mobile library card

How to Access Materials in Closed Stacks

Books

- ◆ Request : Access the website (www.nl.go.kr) / 0-17:00 on the day of visit
* Request time for preserved Closed Stack Materials on Weekends : on Friday before the visit, from 0:00 to 17:00
- ◆ How to use : On the day of visit (10:00~18:00), receive it from the library material borrow & return desk (3rd and 4th floor) and read in the library



Multimedia materials

- ◆ Request : Digital library reservation system (nl.go.kr/dl_reservation) / 0:00 7 days before visiting ~17:00 on the day of visit
- ◆ How to use : On the day of visit (9:00~18:00), receive it from the Multimedia Area (2nd basement floor) and use in the library
